Maths

This half term we will be learning about Place Value, Length, Height, Mass, Volume, Capacity and Temperature. To support your child at home, please encourage them to continue to practise all those fundamental number skills at home on Numbots, www.topmarks.com and the game called Hit the Button!' is strongly advised.

English

In English we will be learning how to write poetry and instructions of how to make a Giant Jam Sandwich! We will also do lots of different English tasks to help continue to improve our spelling and reading as well as our understanding of what we read. We can't wait to start our class reader, 'James and the Giant Peach.'

Science

The children will learn about a variety of habitats and the plants and animals that live there. We will learn to tell the difference between things that are living, dead and things that have never been alive, and apply this in a range of contexts. We will make observations of a local habitat and the creatures that live there, investigating conditions in local microhabitats and how they affect the minibeasts found within them.

R.E. / PHSE / SMSC

Computing

In computing this term we will be grouping data. We will learn that information can be presented in different ways and we will collect simple data and add it to a table or a graph.

Music & P.E.

Mrs Fuller will be teaching music on a Thursday in Holly Class. PE will be taught by a Premier Sports Coach on a Tuesday afternoon and a Thursday afternoon and starts off with games that involve Teamwork. Art / Design Technology
