Lent is a solemn religious observance in the Christian <u>liturgical calendar</u> that begins on <u>Ash Wednesday</u> and ends approximately six weeks later, before <u>Easter Sunday</u> . The purpose of Lent is the preparation of the believer for Easter through <u>prayer</u> , & doing <u>penance</u> . In Lent, many Christians commit to <u>fasting</u> , as well as giving up certain <u>luxuries</u> in order to replicate the account of the sacrifice of Jesus Christ's journey <u>into the desert</u> for 40 days; [6] [7] [8] this is known as one's <u>Lenten sacrifice</u> . Easter or Resurrection Sunday, is a <u>festival</u> and <u>holiday</u> celebrating the <u>resurrection of Jesus</u> from the dead, described in the <u>New Testament</u> as having occurred on the third day of his burial after <u>his crucifixion</u> by the Romans.
