PRAYER ACTIVITY

Seat of Power



- **Equipment**

Wooden chair, luggage tags (pieces of paper or card with a string through the top), pens or pencils.

- **Set up**

Put the chair somewhere on its own. Place the pens and the luggage tags on a table or the floor nearby.

- **Instructions**

Leaders often have a chair that symbolises their power. In America, the President has one in the Oval Office in the White House. In the UK, the Queen has a throne. Let's imagine that our chair represents the people who have power to influence the war in Ukraine... the politicians, the military leaders and the other leaders too.

If you want to, you can write or draw a thought or a prayer onto one of the luggage tags for the leaders who have the power to influence and end the war. Those in Ukraine, in Russia and in other nations too. When you're ready, tie it to the chair.

PRAYER ACTIVITY

Wow Walk



- **Equipment**

Magnifying glasses

- **Set up**

Place magnifying glasses alongside the instructions

- **Instructions**

There are so many things in our world that WOW us! It's important to take time to look and be WOWED.

Take a magnifying glass and go on a short WOW walk. Walk slowly around the area and look for a couple of things that WOW you!

If you want to, say thank you to God for the WOW things you see on your walk.

PRAYER ACTIVITY

Plastic Planet



- **Equipment**

Laminated pages with facts about plastic (<https://lessplastic.co.uk/> Ways to reduce plastic use) and facts about the Planet Earth, a fishing net, used single-use plastics on display, luggage tags, pens.

- **Set up**

Hang the fishing net in the corner of a room or attach to a whiteboard/ceiling.

Christians believe that God told human beings to look after the world. But we do lots of things that damage the world. One example is how much we use single-use plastic, which often ends up in the oceans or in huge rubbish tips for 100s of years, damaging the environment and wildlife too. Recently, laws have been brought into place to try and reduce the amount of single-use plastic being used.

This activity aims to raise awareness about the effects of single-use plastic and encourage pupils to think about how they can live differently to help save the world.

- **Instructions**

The world we live in is beautiful, but human beings are slowly destroying it. One of the ways we are damaging the world is by using single-use plastic.

Take some time to read the facts about our world and how plastic affects it. Now read the ways that we can begin to reduce single-use plastic.

What could you do to help change the amount of plastic in our world? If you want to, you can write a promise or a prayer onto a luggage label and hang it onto the net along with everyone else's promises. Let's save the world together!
