

## **Nursery Provision Offer**

All children who are of nursery age are eligible for the universal 15 hour funding offered by the government beginning from the term after their third birthday. In addition, some parents qualify for a further 15 hours of funding through the government enhanced offer equating to 30 hours of funded nursery education in total.

## **Government Enhanced 15 Hours Education**

Families that meet the criteria set out below will be entitled to a further 15 hours. The criteria

- both parents, or the sole parent in a one parent family, must be working
- each parent must have a weekly minimum income equivalent to 16 hours at the national minimum wage or living wage, and
- neither parent must have income of more than £100,000 per year
