Priorities for 2022-2023

- 1. Teachers demonstrate an in-depth understanding of the content they are teaching. Staff upskilling and CPD mean all teachers are aware of the bigger picture. At the core of the school is a strong structure of leadership and teaching based on intent, implementation and impact.
- 2. To this endeavour the curriculum is well resourced with materials, with each subject carefully planned and provided for to extend experiences and learning. £10000
- 3. Children will have a natural passion for reading, enhanced by a well-resourced library. The skilful matching of phonics knowledge to books means children make better than expected progress from their starting point. A new Systematic Synthetic Phonics Programme (SSPP) will be invested in. £1500

Priorities for 2023-2024

- 2. Resourcing of education continues to be a priority for the school ensuring the children have the correct materials to be coherently taught. This may include more reading book, computing schemes or other curriculum essentials. £5000
- 3.Children have a passion for reading, which in turn sculpts the quality of their writing. Children exceed national expectations in both attainment & progress for reading and writing. SPAG results improve across the school due to the consistent delivery of a new SSPP. £500 (refresher training)
- 4.Staff professional development remains a priority to the school, promoting a bid for excellence and also acknowledging the positive effect on wellbeing. All staff should aspire to continue learning with the support of leaders. £1000
