

Analysis of Parent Survey October 2017



- ❖ In July 2017 a parent survey was distributed, 14 responses were given back in this equated to **21%** of the parenting body.
- ❖ During October parents evening an almost identical parent survey was redistributed (one question around written reports was added) 45 responses were gathered, this equates to **68%** of the parent body.
- ❖ I have chosen what I feel are key questions across the six subsections on the survey. 'School Provision' has not been calculated as there was a common theme in that section. It is also the section with the least consistent responses due to the individual nature of the questions.
